

THE MOST CHILLING WORDS SINCE 'NEW WORLD ORDER'

April 9/09. On March 6, 1991, President George Herbert Walker Bush, at the conclusion of the Persian Gulf War, uttered some words that shivered down the spines of Americans who appreciated their country as an independent, sovereign experiment in constitutional self-government.

"Now, we can see a new world coming into view – a world in which there is the very real prospect of a New World Order," he said.

He went on to expand on this idea, explaining that he envisioned the United Nations freed "to fulfill the historic vision of its founders."

In 1991, that was scary talk. It sounded like Bush had forgotten what America represented in the world – a nation founded on the principles of independence, the rule of law and accountability to the people, rather than just one of many states responsible to a global community that didn't share its ideals.

Last weekend, speaking in Prague, Barack Obama took the New World Order rhetoric to soaring new heights.

"All nations must come together to build a stronger, global regime," he said.

While Bush's earlier phrase set off alarms in some circles, it was ambiguous enough to allow for plausible deniability that he actually intended to work toward some sort of "world government."

Obama's choice of words leaves little doubt about what he means. Though few have so far questioned his desire "to build a stronger, global regime," the words are clear.

(The Oxford Dictionary describes *regime* as: a method of system of government, especially one that has not been elected in a fair way.)

Few freedom-minded people would choose to live under any kind of "regime."

So why would any American seek to be a part of building "a stronger, global regime"? The very idea should be anathema to all of us. Yet, the notion is being championed by none other than the president of the United States. [FULL STORY](#)>

REVIVED ROME CREATING 60,000-STRONG JOINT EU MILITARY REACTION FORCE TO POLICE WORLD'S TROUBLE-SPOTS

April 09. Britain is willing to provide all our Armed Forces to fight under the EU flag in future wars, a minister has revealed.

Europe Minister Caroline Flint said that **every** operational unit of the British Army, the Royal Navy and RAF will be on offer as part of an EU 'force catalogue'. This would help form a 60,000-strong, joint EU military reaction force to police the world's trouble-spots.

This week Flint said: "We are prepared to provide all our forces that are suitable for operations within the EU level of action." This suggested that the entire Army, Navy and RAF will be put at the EU's disposal -with the likely exception of Trident submarines carrying Britain's nuclear deterrent missiles.

Tory MP James Clappison, a member of the European Scrutiny Committee, cautioned that Flint's remarks may have exposed the Government's real attitude. "Under Labor, Britain has an ever-deeper commitment to EU common defense, and many in the EU want a common army," he said.

Opposition critics believe that the Government's rhetoric on European defense is shifting slowly, signalling growing enthusiasm for an EU Army. In October, Defense Secretary John Hutton gave strong backing to French plans for stronger EU military structures, and dismissed opponents of the divisive scheme as 'pathetic'.

France has championed the Euro-Army agenda for years. President Nicolas Sarkozy is pushing for a European military headquarters in Brussels, and more EU Rapid Reaction Forces, each made up of 1,500 troops from member states.

But opponents of the EU reaction force fear that it will become a major stepping stone towards a huge standing EU army, controlled from Brussels, which would undermine Nato and freeze the U.S. out of Europe's security affairs.

Its supporters hope that the new reaction force would also gradually allow the EU to eclipse Nato, or U.S.-led 'coalitions of the willing', in responding to international crises. – www.dailymail.co.uk

KREMLIN TO SUPPLY PA WITH NEW WEAPONS

Apr 7/09. Moscow has promised to supply the Palestinian Authority security forces in the West Bank with new weapons, including two helicopters.

The Russians have also agreed to supply the PA with more than 5,000 AK-47 assault rifles, 300 armored vehicles, 100 pistols and large quantities of ammunition, a senior PA official in Ramallah told *The Jerusalem Post*.

Mahmoud Abbas met with Russian Prime Minister Vladimir Putin and briefed him on the latest developments in the PA territories and Egypt's failed attempts to end the power struggle between Hamas and Fatah.

A PA official said Abbas was hoping to persuade the Russian government to host a Middle East peace conference similar to the one that the former US administration held in Annapolis, Maryland, in 2008.

An official said that Russian President Dmitry Medvedev promised to consider the possibility of convening the peace conference in Moscow later this year.
